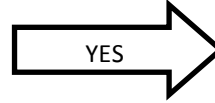


EMS TRANSFER FLOWCHART

The care level required for the transport will be:

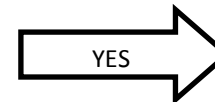
- Antibiotics

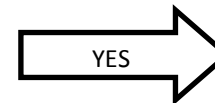
- Advanced Airway with/without vent

- IV Medications with/without Pump
- Morgan Lens
- NG/OG Tube

- Pharmaceutical Restraints



Paramedic

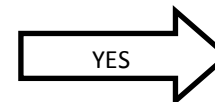
- Albuterol
- Atrovent
- Capnography
- CPAP
- IV Crystalloids
- Dextrose 50% & 10%
- Epinephrine (1:1,000 Anaphylaxis –must have order)
- Narcan
- Nitro (Sublingual)
- Tracheostomy Care
- Vagal Nerve Stimulator



Advanced EMT
(Formerly Intermediate)

NO

- Foley catheter or Suprapubic tube
- Established Feeding Tube (NG, PEG, J-tube - not connected to infusion or suction)
- Left Ventricular Assist Device (LVAD)
- Physical Restraints
- Pulse Oximetry
- Saline Lock (No fluids infusing)
- Suctioning
