Online Medical Control: Concern over ER Drs. not allowing crews to follow protocols, in particular Termination of resuscitation.

Dan has had trainings with staff. Erin expressed concerns that nothing was being done to enforce the trainings or to hold the physicians accountable for following protocols. Dan stated that he can't force the physicians to follow protocols. At this point, the discussion became very heated and Dan left the meeting.

QA/QI:

Inge has asked Forest to train herself & Dan on SIREN so that they can use the data held there for QA/QI and to help identify areas where more training is needed.

Vision & Plan for next 12 Months:

Draw on talent throughout the District to lead trainings

Incorporate some education for TOs at training committee meetings

STEMI:

There is wide spread concern over bypass orders. It is felt that there is a need for protocols for transfer of care of the patient in the event that the responding agency is unable to bypass SVMC and continue to Troy or Albany.

Shawn, Mike, Forest, Erin will meet to put together a picture of what a "road side transfer of care" would entail. This should include:

Feasibility

What it would look like

Education

Professional transfer of care training.

This plan will be on the agenda for next training committee meeting.
